## SUCCESS STORIES

Burgenland was once a poor, economically isolated region along the edge of the iron curtain. In 2000, the region produced only 3% of its electricity consumption.

In 2006, local politicians voted for 100% renewable electricity by 2013, boosting wind power. Since 2013, wind turbines produce 40% more than the demand and export electricity to Vienna.
