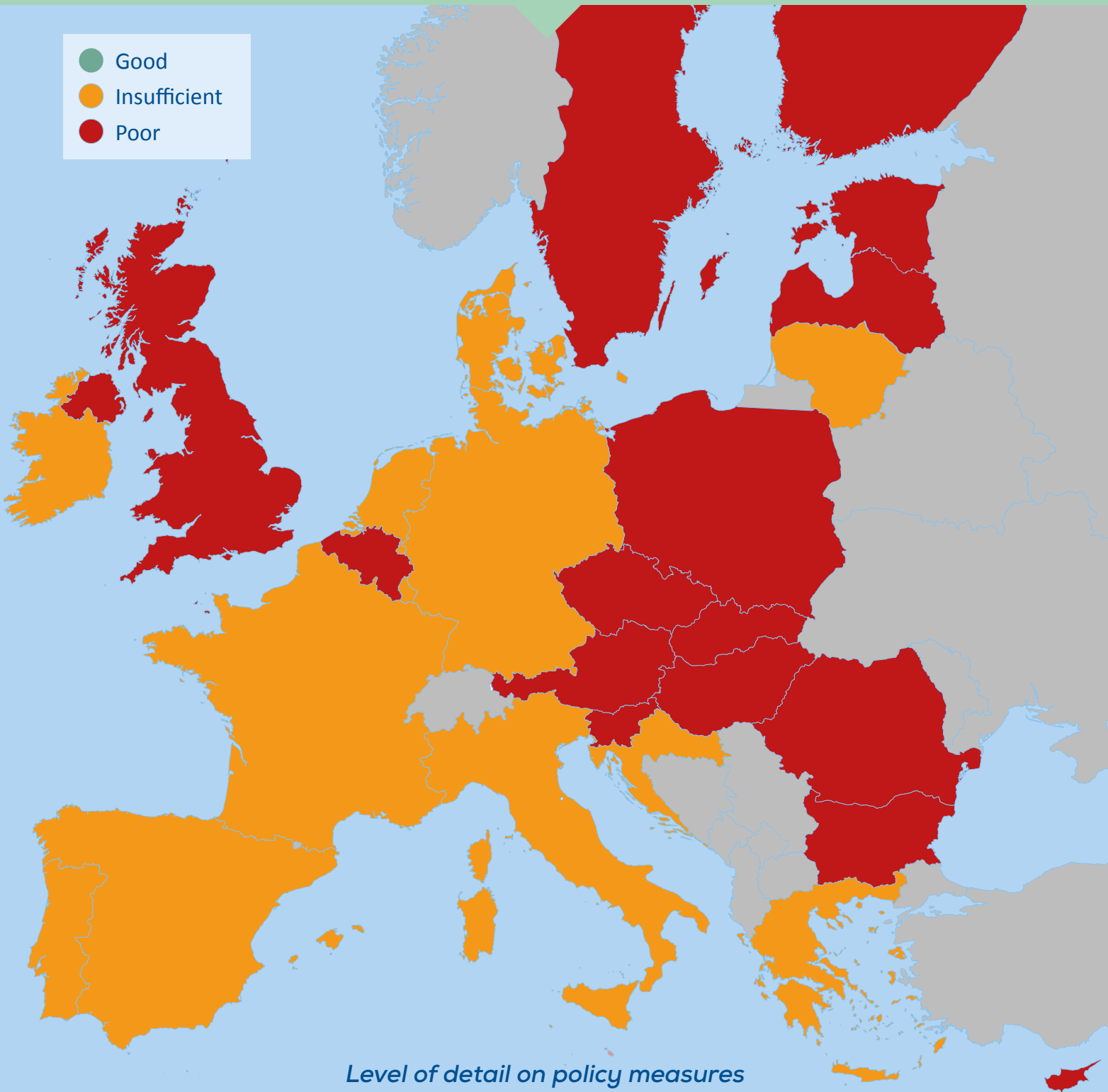


WindEurope's assessment of the draft 2030 National Energy and Climate Plans (NECPs)

EU countries published their objectives and measures on renewable energy for 2030 in draft National Plans. But none of these Plans has the right level of detail on the specific policy measures that will deliver those objectives.
